

CWU Emergency Resolution for the LRC AGM 15 January 2011

“This Conference notes the 3rd Reading given to the Postal Services 2010 Bill in the Commons on January 12th. We condemn the continued efforts of the Government to privatise Royal Mail. We recognise the lasting damage this will do not just to the service Royal Mail currently provides but to the job prospects and terms and conditions, especially pension provisions, of the workforce.

We call on the LRC to give full support to the CWU and the Keep the Post Public Coalition in campaigning to defeat this privatisation measure, including supporting the National Demonstration called in Kingston on 22 January. We further pledge support to any measures the CWU may take in future to defend jobs, conditions and pension provisions threatened by privatisation, damaging regulation and to ensure that Royal Mail abides by the terms of existing negotiated agreements.”
